### Why use the Shuttle?

The Shuttle provides an easy alternative to using cars to travel to destinations within the central city. Here are four good reasons to use the Shuttle:

- **Free travel** - only walking is cheaper, but why walk when you can ride for free!
- **Stress-free travel** - no worries about finding parking or the cost of petrol
- **Convenient travel** - there's a Shuttle every 10 minutes during the day time
- **Comfortable travel** - easy access buses are available on most services

## The free central city Shuttle



Christchurch has a free central city shuttle operating seven days per week. The Shuttle, which is a distinctive yellow colour, runs every 10 minutes during the day and every 15 minutes in the evenings.

The Shuttle provides a convenient means of travel between destinations in the central city, from Hoyts 8 cinemas and CPIT (Christchurch Polytechnic) in the south to the Town Hall, Convention Centre and Casino in the north.

A route map showing all the stops and key attractions is on the facing page of this brochure.

The Shuttle timetable is as follows:

### Monday - Thursday

Every 10 minutes      7.30am - 7pm  
 Every 15 minutes      7pm - 10.30pm

### Friday

Every 10 minutes      7.30am - 10.30pm

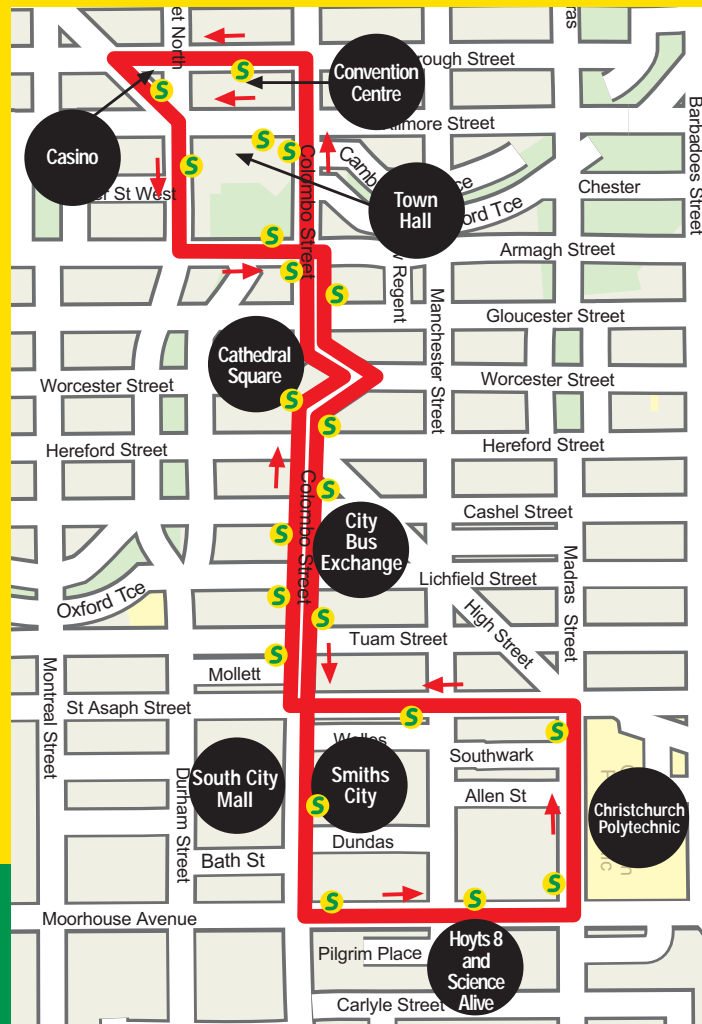
### Saturday

Every 10 minutes      8am - 10.30pm

### Sunday\*

Every 10 minutes      10am - 5pm  
 Every 15 minutes      5pm - 8pm
